### January 25th to February 7th, 2021

Route: Tel Aviv, Caesarea, Haifa, San Juan de Acre, Safed, Galilea, Tabgha, Capernaum, Yardenit, Nazareth, Jerusalem, Belen and Tel Aviv. Istanbul, Izmir, Pergamum, Kusadasi, Pamukkale, Istanbul.

# Day 1 - Tuesday 26. Tel Aviv / Caesarea / Mount Carmel / Mejido / Nazareth / Cana / Nazareth 0 Tiberias

We arrive in Israel at Ben Gurion Airport near Tel Aviv. After going through customs and collecting the luggage, we will meet the guide and go to the bus. We begin the day of our spiritual journey in the Holy Land by heading towards the north along the Mediterranean Sea to visit Caesarea, the ancient port built by Herod the Great. Pablo was imprisoned here and this was the place where Pedro converted the first gentile. Then, we will ascend Mount Carmel, the place of Elijah and the prophets of Baal. We will go to Cana of Galilee, where Jesus performed his first miracle and then We will visit Mejido with its 24 levels of civilizations. This was the city of floats Roman roads and one of the most strategic points of roads in the world in the time of Old Testament. Then dinner and the rest of the night at the hotel.

## Day 2 - Wednesday 27 Galilea Boat Ride / Banias / Philipo / El Bote de Jesus / Nazareth O Tiberias

This morning we will start the day with a wonderful boat ride on the Sea of Galilee, we will stop at sea for a short service. The boat will head towards the Kibbutz of "Nof Ginosar "to see the recent discovery of the ancient boat from the time of Jesus. Magdala's "new" archaeological sight dates back to 2000 years ago. We will see original houses and shops, and a beautiful mosaic floor in the synagogue. This place is truly as if we were in the time of Jesus. Our visit to the village of Nazareth, which is a recreation of a town in the time of Jesus, will be one of the most important events of the day. We will head north to visit the edges of the Lebanon and Syria, Mount Bental, the height of the Golan, the beginning of the Jordan River and Caesarea de Philip. Then dinner and the rest of the night at the hotel.

# Day 3 - Thursday 28 Mount of Beatitudes / Tabgha / Capernaum / Rio Jordan / Nazareth O Tiberias

After breakfast, we will go to the Mount of Beatitudes, where Jesus preached the Sermon. from the Mount. This morning we will have a short service, united, as we observe the calm sea. We will go a short distance to visit Tabgha, the place where the crowds ate the bread and fish, and we will go to St. Peter's Primary Church at 10 along the coast. A short trip takes us to Capernaum, the center of the ministry of Jesus where we can see the house of San Pedro and visit the ruins of the synagogue of the 2nd century. A delicious lunch of fish from San Pedro awaits us in a famous Kibbutz by the sea. We will go up to observe a complete and spectacular view of the Sea of Galilee region. Our day ends at the Jordan River with an opportunity to baptism. Then dinner and the rest of the night at the hotel.

#### Day 4 - Friday 29 Beit Shean / Jerico / Dead Sea

This morning we will travel a short stretch through the Jordan Valley to "Beit Shean", one of the ancient cities of Decapolis dating from the 5th century B.C. Today it's the place of largest archaeological excavation in Israel. We will continue to the south of Jerico, where we will observe the Mount of Temptation and Mount Nebo in Jordan, from where Moses saw the promised land. We will stay in a luxury hotel next to the Dead Sea - this is the lowest point on earth, where we can float in the sea and enjoy the properties therapeutic water without the possibility of sinking. We will check in early to have time to enjoy the treatment or relax in the pool. Then dinner with the Bedouins in Kfar Hanokdim the rest of the night at the hotel.

#### Day 5 - Saturday 30 Masada / Ein Gedi / Qumran / Jerusalem

This morning we will travel 10 along the Dead Sea towards Masada and climb on the cable car to visit the palace of Herod the Great and his famous fortresses in the footD of the mountain, where from A.D. 70-73, the Jews defended the state of Rome. We will see the fascinating remains of Herod's palaces, warehouses, cisterns, and the ancient synagogues. Our next stop is the beautiful natural preservation of '' Ein Gedi ". Before leaving the area, we will visit Qumran, the discovery of the place of the Dead Sea scrolls. Then, we will climb about 4000 feet towards Jerusalem. Our First view of the Golden City will be from Mount Scopus where we will have time to reflect on the Holy City. Afterwards, dinner and the rest of the night in Jerusalem.

#### Day 6 - Sunday 31 Jerusalem

We will start in Jerusalem on the Mount of Olives, with a spectacular view of the eastern

walls of the Old City (Murallas). From there we will walk down the street of Palm Sunday to the Jardin de Getsemanf. We will have a service in the Garden with time to reflect on this loving place ... olive trees around 2000 years old, so far they are standing. We will travel around the ancient walls of the city, observing the tombs of Absalon and Zacharias and we will continue towards the House of Caifa, where Jesus was arrested the night before the crucifixion ... There we will stand at the same stone where Jesus walked to Mount Zion. Later, we will visit the Aposento Stop (The Room of the Last Supper) and we will have a short service. After lunch, We will walk through the "Cardo", the Heart of the busy and Old Jerusalem, after we will visit the Western Walls (Wailing Walls) where we will write prayers on paper and deposit them in the cracks in the wall. We will continue towards Tunnels of the Rabbis where we will be in a place considered close to the most holy place. We will proceed to the Pool of Bethesda and the Church of Saint Anne, where we can sing in this church with a 10 second echo! We will leave the Old City through the Porton of the Lions. Then, dinner and the rest of the night at the hotel.

#### Day 7 - Monday February 1 Jerusalem - Bethlehem

Today, we will travel a short distance to Belen. There we will see the Shepherds Field and we will walk through the caves of the Shepherds and the Ancient Church of the Nativity of 1600 years. We will have time to shop and see the famous carved olive woods, a specialty of the artisans of Belen. We return to Jerusalem and proceed to Ancient City to visit the Museum of Davidson the South Steps to the Temple of the Mountain. We will go to "Lithostrotos", where we will see the real streets of Jerusalem by where Jesus walked, the ruins of the Pilate's palace of judgment and the "Ecce Homo Arch". Then, we will walk La Via Dolorosa, passing through the intriguing market and bazaars.

Tonight, for those of you who would like to have an evening event, we can go to the sound show and lights in the "Citadel" the cost is \$ 10.00 per person in the Tower of David. Afterwards, dinner and the rest of the night at the hotel.

#### Day 8 - Tuesday February 2 Jerusalem

This morning, we will begin our last day of walks in the Holy City with a visit adventurer to the City of David and the Tunel de Hezequias (Tunel de Siloe). We will have time for those who would like to walk through the tunnel. Then, we will go to the Sanctuary of the books where are the scrolls found in the Dead Sea and see the wonderful model of Jerusalem in the time of Christ. We will end the day visiting the "Grave Garden". Which is considered as the highlight of our walk.

There we will have time of adoration in a private area and we will participate in Holy Communion. He resurrected!, He is not here!, What a wonderful and significant conclusion to these days truly memorable!. Later, dinner and the rest of the night at the hotel.

# Day 9 - Wednesday February 3 End of services in Israel and start of our trip to Istanbul and Turkey.
