Israel Holy Land, Italy, Rome

January 25th to February 7th,2021



Day 1 - Tuesday 26. Tel Aviv / Caesarea / Mount Carmel / Mejido / Nazareth / Cana / Nazareth or Tiberias

We arrived in Israel at Ben Gurion airport near Tel Aviv. After going through customs and collect the luggage, we meet the guide and go to the bus. We started the day of our spiritual journey in the Holy Land heading north along the Mediterranean Sea to visit Caesarea, the ancient port built by Herod the Great. Pablo was imprisoned here and this was the place where Pedro converted the first gentile. Then, we ascend Mount Carmel, the place of Elijah and the prophets of Baal. We will go to Cana of Galilee, where Jesus performed his first miracle and then We will visit Mejido with its 24 levels of civilizations. This was the city of floats Roman roads and one of the most strategic points of roads in the world in the time of Old Testament. Dinner and the rest of the night at the hotel.

Day 2 - Wednesday 27 Galilea Boat Tour / Banias / Philipo / El Bote de Jesus / Nazareth or Tiberias

This morning we start the day with a wonderful boat ride on the Sea of Galilee, we stopped at sea for a short service. The boat will head towards the Kibbutz of "Nof Ginosar" to see the recent discovery of the ancient boat from the time of Jesus. A Magdala's "new" archeological view dates back 2000 years. We will see original houses and shops, and a beautiful mosaic floor in the Synagogue. This place is truly as if we were in the time of Jesus. Our visit to the village of Nazareth which is a recreation of a town in the time of Jesus will be one of the most important events of the day. We will head north to visit the edges of the Lebanon and Syria, Mount Bental, the height of the Golan, the beginning of the Jordan River and Caesarea de Philip. Dinner and the rest of the night at the hotel.

Day 3 - Thursday 28 Mount of Beatitudes / Tabgha / Capernaum / Rio Jordan / Nazareth or Tiberias

After breakfast, we went to the Mount of Beatitudes, where Jesus preached the Sermon from the Mount. This morning we will have a short service, united, as we observe the calm sea. We will go a short distance to visit Tabgha, the place where the crowds ate the bread and fish, and we go to St. Peter's Primary Church along along the coast. A short trip takes us to Capernaum, the center of the ministry of Jesus where we can see the house of San Pedro and visit the ruins of the Synagogue of the 2nd century. A delicious lunch of fish from San Pedro awaits us in a famous Kibbutz by the sea. We will go up to observe a complete and spectacular view of the Sea of Galilee region. Our day ends at the Jordan River with an opportunity to baptism. Dinner and the rest of the night at the hotel.

Day 4 - Friday 29 Beit Shean / Jerico / Dead Sea

This morning we will travel a short stretch through the Jordan Valley to "Beit Shean", one of the ancient cities of Decapolis dating from the 5th century B.C. Today is the place of the largest archaeological excavation in Israel. We will continue to the south of Jerico, where we will observe the Mount of Temptation and Mount Nebo in Jordan, from where Moses saw the promised land. We will stay in a luxury hotel found in the Dead Sea - this is the lowest point on earth, where we can float in the sea and enjoy the properties therapeutic water without the possibility of sinking. We checked in early for have time to enjoy the treatment or relax in the pool. Dinner with the Bedouins in Kfar Hanokdim the rest of the night at the hotel.

Day 5 - Saturday 30 Masada / Ein Gedi / Qumran / Jerusalem

This morning we will travel along the Dead Sea towards Masada and climb on the cable car to visit the palace of Herod the Great and his famous fortresses in the mountain peak, where from A.D. 70-73, the Jews defended the state of Rome. We will see the fascinating remains of Herod's palaces, warehouses, cisterns, and the Ancient synagogues. Our next stop is the beautiful natural preserve of "Ein Gedi". Before leaving the area, we will visit Qumran, the discovery of the place of the Dead Sea scrolls. Then, we will climb about 4000 feet towards Jerusalem. Our First view of the Golden City will be from Mount Scopus where we will have time to reflect on the Holy City. Dinner and the rest of the night in Jerusalem.

Day 6 - Sunday 31 Jerusalem

We will start in Jerusalem on the Mount of Olives, with a spectacular view of the eastern walls of the Old City (Murallas). From there we will walk down the street from Domingo de Ramos to the Jardin de Getsemani. We will have a service in the Garden with time to reflect on this loving place ... olive trees about 2000 years old, so far they are standing. We will travel around the ancient walls of the city, observing the tombs of Absalon and Zacarias and we will continue towards the House of Caifa, where Jesus was arrested the night before the crucifixion ... There we will stand on the same stone where Jesus walked to Mount Zion. Later, we will visit the Upper Room (The Room of the Last Supper) and we will have a short service. After the lunch, we will walk through the "Cardo", the heart of

the busy and Antigua Jerusalem, then we will visit the Western Walls (Wailing Walls) where We will write sentences on paper and deposit them in the cracks in the wall. We will continue to the Tunel de los Rabinos where we will be in a place considered close of the holy place. We will proceed to the pool of Bethesda and the Church of Saint Anne, where we can sing in this church with a 10 second echo! We will leave the Old City through the Porton de los Leones. Dinner and the rest of the night at the hotel.

Day 7 - Monday February 1 Jerusalem - Bethlehem

Today, we will travel a short distance to Belen. There we will see the Field of the Shepherds and We will walk through the caves of the Shepherds and the Old Church of the Nativity of 1600 years. We will have time to shop and see the famous carved olive woods, a specialty of the artisans of Belen. We return to Jerusalem and proceed to the Old City to visit the Davidson Museum the South Steps to the Temple Mount. We will go to the "lithostrotos", where we will see the real streets of Jerusalem where Jesus walked, the ruins of Pilate's palace of judgment and the "Ecce Homo Arch". Then, we will walk the Via Dolorosa, we will pass through the intriguing market and the bazaars. Tonight, for those of you who would like to have an evening event, we can go to sound and light show at the "Citadel" the cost is \$ 10.00 per person at the Tower of David. Dinner and the rest of the night at the hotel.

Day 8 - Tuesday February 2 Jerusalem

Ethis morning, we will begin our last day of walks in the Holy City with a visit adventurer to the City of David and the Tunel de Hezequias (Tunel de Siloe). We will have time for those who would like to walk through the tunnel. Then we will go to the Sanctuary of the books where are the scrolls found in the Dead Sea and see the wonderful model of Jerusalem in the time of Christ. We will end the day visiting the Jardin de la Tumba. He which is considered as the highlight of our walk! There we will have time of adoration in a private area and we will participate in Holy Communion. He resurrected! He not here! What a wonderful and significant conclusion to these days truly memorable! Dinner and the rest of the night at the hotel.

Italy, Rome (Pompeii – Naples – Capri)

Day 9 - Wednesday 3 ROME

Pick up at the Hotel and our receptive will take the Group to the Airport to take flight to ROME: Arrival in Rome and transfer to the hotel. Our Guide will receive the Group at the Hotel to coordinate the itinerary. Rest of the afternoon and free night. Accommodation in Rome.

Day 10 - Thursday 4 ROME

Breakfast. Departure for a panoramic visit of the city, during which we can admire emblematic areas such as the Vatican City, Castel San! 'Angelo, the Lungotevere, the Tiber Island, Porta Portese, the Mouth of the Truth, etc., and we will see some of its great monuments such as the Circus Maximus, the Baths of Caracalla, the Pyramid of Cestia, the Colosseum (exterior), the Celio Hill, the Basilicas of San Juan de Letran and Santa Maria Mayor (exterior), Termini Station, the Place de la Republica, via Veneto and Villa Borghese, among others. Then, We will visit the Vatican City State. We will visit the Plaza de San Pedro, the Basilica of San Pedro, in which from the top dominates the grandiose and suggestive Michelangelo's dome, the Sistine Chapel, where we can observe the majestic "frescoes" and the Vatican Museums. Lunch. Free afternoon to continue getting to know the city. We recommend an optional excursion to "Baroque Rome", touring the Baroque and Renaissance neighborhood of the city, we will see among others: Piazza Navona, Fontana di Trevi, Piazza di Spagna, etc. Accommodation.

Day 11 - Friday 5 ROME

Breakfast. Include in the itinerary Full Day Excursion for Get to know Naples, Pompeii and Capri with Lunch or Dinner included. Accommodation in Capri

Day 12 - Saturday 6 ROME

Breakfast. Departure for an excursion through "Ancient Rome": We will begin our walk through the Basilica of Saint Peter in Chains that contains the majestic sculpture of Moses by Michelangelo, in addition to guarding the relic of the chains that held the apostle Saint Peter in Rome. We will continue our visit enjoying unparalleled panoramic views of the Colosseum (exterior) and we will walk along the avenue of the Imperial Forums to learn about the history of the Forum Roman, religious, political and administrative center of the capital of the Empire, from its terraces. At the end of the tour, we will reach Venice Square and Capitol Square designed by Michelangelo and seat of the city hall of Rome since remote times. Lunch. Free afternoon. accommodation
