Day 1 -Tel Aviv / Caesarea / Mount Carmel / Mejido / Nazareth / Cana / Nazareth o Tiberias

We arrive in Israel at Ben Gurion Airport near Tel Aviv. After going through customs and collecting the luggage, we will meet the guide and go to the bus. We begin the day of our spiritual journey in the Holy Land by heading towards the north along the Mediterranean Sea to visit Caesarea, the ancient port built by Herod the Great. Pablo was imprisoned here and this was the place where Pedro converted the first gentile. Then, we will ascend Mount Carmel, the place of Elijah and the prophets of Baal. We will go to Cana of Galilee, where Jesus performed his first miracle and then We will visit Mejido with its 24 levels of civilizations. This was the city of floats Roman roads and one of the most strategic points of roads in the world in the time of Old Testament. Then dinner and the rest of the night at the hotel.

Day 2 - Galilea Boat Tour / Banias / Philipo / El Bote de Jesus / Nazaret o Tiberias

This morning we start the day with a wonderful boat ride in the Sea of Galilee, we will stop at the sea for a short service. The boat will head towards the Kibbutz of "Nof Ginosar" to see the recent discovery of the ancient boat from the time of Jesus. A "New" archaeological view of Magdala dates back to 2000 years behind. We will see original houses and shops, and a beautiful mosaic floor in the Synagogue. This place is truly as if we were in the time of Jesus. Our visit to the village of Nazareth which is a recreation of a town in the times of Jesus will be one of the most important events of the day. We will head towards him north to visit the borders of the Lebanon and Syria, Mount Bental, the height of the Golan, the beginning of the Jordan River and Caesarea Philippi. Afterwards, dinner and the rest of the night at the hotel.

Day 3 - Mount of Beatitudes / Tabgha / Capernaum / Jordan River / Nazareth o Tiberias

After breakfast, we will go to the Mount of Beatitudes, where Jesus preached the Sermon on the Mount. This morning we will have a short service, united, as well as observing the calm sea. We will go a short distance to visit Tabgha, the place where the crowds ate the bread and fish, and we will go to the Primary Church of San Pedro along the coast. A short trip takes us to Capernaum, the center of Jesus' ministry where we can see the house of Saint Pedro and visit the ruins of the 2nd century synagogue. A delicious lunch from the Fish from San Pedro awaits us in a famous kibbutz by the sea. We will go up to observe a complete and spectacular view of the region of the sea of Galilee. Our day ends at the Jordan River with an opportunity for baptism. Then dinner and the rest of the night at the hotel.

Day 4 - Beit Shean / Jerico / Dead Sea

This morning we will travel a short section through the Jordan Valley to "Beit Shean", one of the ancient cities of Decapolis dating from the 5th century B.C. Today it is the site of the largest archaeological excavation in Israel. We will continue to south of Jerico, where we will observe the Mount of Temptation and Mount Nebo in Jordan, from where Moses saw the Promised Land. We will stay in a hotel in luxury next to the Dead Sea - this is the lowest point on earth, where we can float in the sea and enjoy the therapeutic properties of water without the possibility to sink. We will

check in early to have time to enjoy the treatment or relax in the pool.

Afterwards, dinner with the Bedouins at Kfar Hanokdim el rest of the night at the hotel.

Day 5 - Masada / Ein Gedi / Qumran / Jerusalem

This morning we will travel along the Dead Sea towards Masada and climb the

cable car to visit the palace of Herod the Great and its famous forts on the mountain peak, where from A.D. 70-73, the Jews defended the state of Rome. We will see the fascinating remains of Herod's palaces, warehouses, cisterns, and ancient synagogues. Our next stop is the beautiful natural preservation of "Ein Gedi". Before leaving the area, we will visit Qumran, the discovery of the place of the Dead Sea scrolls. Then we will go up near 4000 feet towards Jerusalem. Our first view of the Golden City will be from Mount Scopus where we will have time to reflect on the Holy City. Then dinner and the rest of the night in Jerusalem.

Day 6 - Jerusalen

We will start in Jerusalem on the Mount of Olives, with a spectacular view of the eastern walls of the Old City (Murallas). From there we will walk down Domingo de Ramos street to the Jardin de Getsemani. We will have a service in the Garden with time to reflect on this loving place. .. filled with olive trees about 2000 years old, so far they are still standing. We will travel around of the ancient city walls, observing the tombs of Absalon and Zacharias and we will continue to the House of Caifas, where Jesus was arrested the night before of the crucifixion ... There we will stand on the same stone where Jesus walked, towards

Mount Zion. Later, we will visit the Upper Room (The room of the Last Dinner) and we will have a short service. After lunch, we will walk through of the "Cardo", the Heart of the busy and Old Jerusalem, then we will visit the Western Walls (Wailing Walls) where we will write sentences in papers and deposited them in the cracks in the wall. We will continue to Tunnels of the Rabbis where we will be in a place considered close to the most holy place. We will proceed to the pool of Bethesda and the Church of Saint Anne, where we can sing in this church with a 10 second echo! We will leave the Old City to through the Porton de los Leones. Afterwards, dinner and the rest of the night at the hotel

Day 7 - Jerusalem - Bethlehem

Today, we will travel a short distance to Belen. There we will see the Field of Pastors and we will walk through the caves of the Shepherds and the Old Church of the Nativity of 1600 years. We will have time to shop and see the famous Carved olive wood, a specialty of the artisans of Belen. We will come back to Jerusalem and proceed to the Old City to visit the Museum of Davidson the South Steps to the Temple Mount. We will go to the "Uthostrotos", where we will see the real streets of Jerusalem where Jesus walked, the ruins of Pilate's judgment palace and the "Ecce Homo Arch". Then we will walk Via Dolorosa, we will pass through the intriguing market and bazaars. Tonight, for those of you who would like to have an evening event, we can go to the sound show and Lights at the "Citadel" the price is \$ 10.00 per person at the Tower of David. Dinner and the rest of the night at the hotel.

Day 8 - Jerusalem

This morning, we will begin our last day of walks in the Holy City with an adventurous visit to the City of David and the Hezequias Tunnel (Siloe Tunnel). We will have time for those who would like to walk through the tunnel. Then we will go to the Sanctuary of books where the scrolls found in the Sea are Dead and see the wonderful model of Jerusalem in the time of Christ. We will end the day visiting the Jardin de la Umba. iEl which is considered as the highlight of our walk! There we will have time of worship in a private area and we will participate in Holy Communion. "He rose again; He is not here! What a wonderful and significant conclusion to these days truly memorable! Dinner and the rest of the night at the hotel.

Day 9 - Israel end of service - Destination Miami
